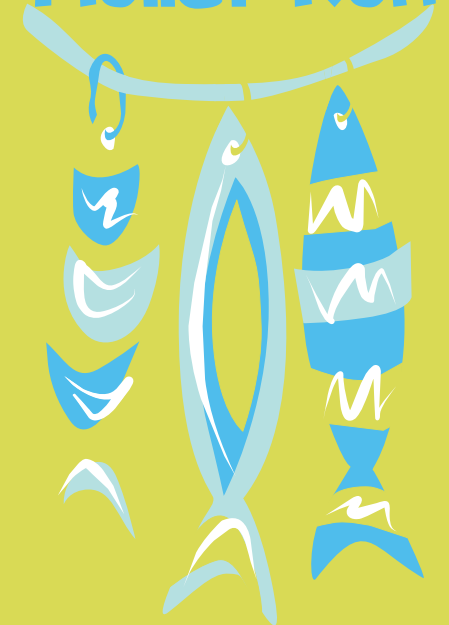
Fund raising includes The Mullet Run, Grant-writing, Sponsorship campaign.

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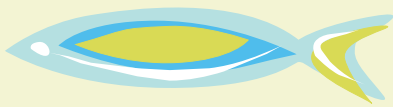

# MULLET RUN - 5K and 1 Mile Fun Run/Walk

**DATE & TIME:** October 8, 2011. 5K race will start at 8:30 AM. Fun Run will start at approximately 9:30 AM.  
**LOCATION:** 5K starts on Bancroft Street and finishes on Magnolia Street at Knoll Park.  
1 Mile starts and finishes on Magnolia Street at Knoll Park.

**ORGANIZED BY:** The BayART Project  
**BENEFITING:** The BayART Project which teaches Bay Area youth life skills and art techniques through public art projects.

**DISTANCE:** Certified 5K (AL09025JD) and 1 Mile (AL09026JD) courses. Fluids will be provided along the race course.

**REGISTRATION:** Pre-register by mail (entries should be postmarked by September 30), in person at McCoy Outdoor in Mobile, Running Wild or Fairhope Museum of History in Fairhope, until noon on October 7 or online at www.Active.com until midnight October 7. Race day registration from 7:15- 8:15 AM at the Fairhope Museum of History on Bancroft Street.

**AWARDS:** Original art awards created by Ameri'ca for top finishers in the following categories: male and female Overall, Masters, Grandmasters, Senior Grandmasters, and Race walkers. Top three male and female in age groups: 9 and under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-99.

**SHIRTS:** Specially designed long sleeved shirts for all pre-registered participants. To be guaranteed a t-shirt on race day, please register by September 30, 2011.

**POST-RACE PARTY:** A fabulous variety of food and beverages will be provided after the race. All registered participants will be eligible for the door prize drawings - you must be present to win.

**If the weather is unseasonably warm or cold, use the customary racing precautions with which you should be familiar and take advantage of the water along the course. Stop running/walking and seek help if you stop sweating and feel nauseous or dizzy. If you see a fellow runner/walker who appears to be in trouble, please stop and help if you can.**
